Frequently Asked Questions

1. Q: What is Colonel's Flying Aces?

O A: Colonel's Flying Aces is a Community of RC enthusiast who fly remote controlled airplanes and train others to fly RC planes.

2. Q: How does one join the group and what are the fees to join?

O A: CFA members myst join the AMA to be part of the group. There is also a CFA membership fee. That fee is \$100.00 per years. Interested parties may fly as a guest up to 4 months.

3. Q: What is the cost to purchase an RC plane?

O A: Beginner Planes like the Hobby Zone Aero Scout cost about \$269.00. The costs increase from there.

4. Q: When do the members fly?

O A: Weather is always a determining factor. Most member fly on Saturdays. There is a club group chat for members. We contact the group by text and let them know when we intend to fly.

5. Q: Are non-members allowed to fly?

O A: Yes, but only when a member is present.

6. Q: Are spectators allowed?

O A: Yes, but spectators must adhere to the rules of the club and remain in areas designated for non-members.

7. Q: What type of planes do member fly? Gas/Electric?

O A: Both gas and electric (battery powered)

8. Q: Is training available to non-members and new members?

O A: Yes, we have certified trainers who will schedule a time to help new pilots. During the training period, no membership is required and there is no fee for the training. We offer this service at no cost to the participant to help them succeed in becoming an RC pilot.
